第一章 总则

第三条 本制度所称资金使用，是指公司各项业务活动所需的资金支出。

第四条 本制度所称财务监督，是指对公司财务活动的合法性、合规性进行审查和监督。

第五条 本制度所称财务考核，是指对公司各部门财务指标完成情况进行的考核与评价。
