THE UNIVERSITY OF THE SOUTH PACIFIC (USP) SCHOOLS OF DISTANCE EDUCATION (SDE) AND THE SCHOOLS OF INFORMATION TECHNOLOGY (SIT) ARE PLEASED TO ANNOUNCE THE ADMISSIONS FOR THE BACHELOR OF SCIENCE (HONOURS) - COMPUTER SCIENCE PROGRAM.

THE PROGRAM IS A FOUR-YEAR DEGREE PROGRAM THAT PROVIDES STUDENTS WITH A SOLID FOUNDATION IN COMPUTER SCIENCE AND PREPARES THEM FOR CAREERS IN THE FIELD. THE PROGRAM IS DESIGNED TO BE FLEXIBLE AND ACCOMMODATE STUDENTS WHO ARE WORKING OR HAVE OTHER COMMITMENTS.

STUDENTS WHO COMPLETION OF THE PROGRAM WILL BE ELIGIBLE FOR A HONOURS DEGREE IN COMPUTER SCIENCE. THE PROGRAM IS ACCREDITED BY THE PACIFIC RIM CONFERENCE OF UNIVERSITY VICE-CHANCELORS (PRCUVC) AND THE ASSOCIATION OF AMERICAN UNIVERSITIES (AAU). THE PROGRAM IS ALSO ACCREDITED BY THE SOCIETY OF PROFESSIONAL ENGINEERS (SPE) AND THE INSTITUTE OF ELECTRICAL AND ELECTRONICS ENGINEERS (IEEE).

THE PROGRAM IS OFFERED IN BOTH ENGLISH AND FRENCH. STUDENTS WHO ARE NOT NATIVE SPEAKERS OF ENGLISH OR FRENCH WILL BE REQUIRED TO TAKE ENGLISH AS A SECOND LANGUAGE (ESL) OR FRENCH AS A SECOND LANGUAGE (FSL) COURSES. THE PROGRAM IS ALSO AVAILABLE TO STUDENTS WHO ARE CURRENTLY ENROLLED IN A BACHELOR'S DEGREE PROGRAM AT ANOTHER UNIVERSITY.

STUDENTS WHO ARE CURRENTLY ENROLLED IN A BACHELOR'S DEGREE PROGRAM AT ANOTHER UNIVERSITY MAY BE ELIGIBLE FOR CREDIT TRANSFER. THE UNIVERSITY WILL CONSIDER CREDIT TRANSFER FROM ANY ACCREDITED BACHELOR'S DEGREE PROGRAM. THE UNIVERSITY WILL ALSO CONSIDER CREDIT TRANSFER FROM A BACHELOR'S DEGREE PROGRAM AT ANOTHER UNIVERSITY IF THE STUDENT HAS COMPLETED A SIGNIFICANT PORTION OF THE PROGRAM.

STUDENTS WHO ARE CURRENTLY ENROLLED IN A BACHELOR'S DEGREE PROGRAM AT ANOTHER UNIVERSITY MAY BE ELIGIBLE FOR CREDIT TRANSFER. THE UNIVERSITY WILL CONSIDER CREDIT TRANSFER FROM ANY ACCREDITED BACHELOR'S DEGREE PROGRAM. THE UNIVERSITY WILL ALSO CONSIDER CREDIT TRANSFER FROM A BACHELOR'S DEGREE PROGRAM AT ANOTHER UNIVERSITY IF THE STUDENT HAS COMPLETED A SIGNIFICANT PORTION OF THE PROGRAM.
