THE CONFERENCE WAS OPENED BY
THE PRESIDENT OF THE ASSEMBLY OF
PARLIAMENTS OF THE FRENCH COMMUNITY,
MR. CHARLES DE GAULLE, ON 26 SEPTEMBER
1948. HE DELIVERED A SPEECH IN WHICH
HE STATED THAT THE CONFERENCE WAS
THE FIRST OF ITS KIND SINCE THE
SECOND WORLD WAR AND THAT IT WAS
A SIGN OF THE REBIRTH OF INTERNATIONAL
COOPERATION.

DELEGATIONS FROM 28 STATES AND
OBSERVERS FROM 10 OTHER STATES.
THE DELEGATIONS WERE REPRESENTED
BY 100 MEMBERS AND 50 OBSERVERS.
THE CONFERENCE WAS PRESIDED OVER
BY MR. CHARLES DE GAULLE.
