二、 會員
凡具有中華民國國籍，具有醫學專業背景，並經本會審核合格者，均可申請加入本會。
會員分為正式會員、名譽會員、贊助會員、通訊會員等四種。
正式會員須具備下列條件：
1. 具有醫學博士學位，或在醫學領域具有相當之專業成就。
2. 具有十年以上之臨床或研究經驗。
3. 具有良好之醫藥倫理紀錄。
名譽會員由本會評選委員會評選，其條件由評選委員會決定。
贊助會員由本會評選委員會評選，其條件由評選委員會決定。
通訊會員由本會評選委員會評選，其條件由評選委員會決定。

三、 組織
本會設理事會、監事會、評選委員會、學術委員會、倫理委員會、國際交流委員會等。
理事會為本會之最高決策機構，由全體會員選舉產生，任期四年，連選得連任一次。
監事會為本會之監督機構，由全體會員選舉產生，任期四年，連選得連任一次。
評選委員會為本會之評選機構，由全體會員選舉產生，任期四年，連選得連任一次。
學術委員會為本會之學術研究機構，由全體會員選舉產生，任期四年，連選得連任一次。
倫理委員會為本會之醫藥倫理機構，由全體會員選舉產生，任期四年，連選得連任一次。
國際交流委員會為本會之國際交流機構，由全體會員選舉產生，任期四年，連選得連任一次。

四、 選舉、罷免、修改章程
本會之理事會、監事會、評選委員會、學術委員會、倫理委員會、國際交流委員會等，均由全體會員選舉產生。
選舉、罷免、修改章程之程序，均依本章程之規定辦理。
本會之選舉、罷免、修改章程等事項，均須經全體會員大會三分之二以上之出席，及出席會員三分之二以上之同意，方得通過。
