INTERNATIONAL CONFERENCE ON INTERNATIONAL LAW, 1978

The International Conference on International Law, 1978, was held in Vienna, Austria, from 8 to 18 June 1978. It was convened by the United Nations Secretary-General, Mr. Waldhauser, in accordance with the decision of the General Assembly of the United Nations, adopted on 12 December 1977, in which the Assembly requested the Secretary-General to convene a conference of plenipotentiaries of States to discuss the possibility of concluding a new international instrument on the law of the sea.

The Conference was held in the Conference Centre of the United Nations Secretariat Building, Vienna, Austria. It was attended by 112 States, 10 of which were invited by the Secretary-General, and 10 States which were invited by the Secretary-General of the United Nations Conference on the Law of the Sea, held in Geneva, 1976. The Conference was presided over by Mr. Waldhauser, Secretary-General of the United Nations.
